In principle, students at BA and MA studies come for a full semester/academic year, while PhD students are allowed to participate in shorter-term mobility programs.
Does your University offer online courses? If yes, on which online open sources?	There are no officially accredited online courses taught at UB. There are blended modules that are now being held due to the covid-19 pandemic, usually via Teams and Zoom platforms.

There is a national grant offered by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Serbia and announced through Serbian diplomatic missions abroad (requirements, deadlines, etc. UB does not have any information on application and selection procedures).

Evaluation system (grades)	Students' success in the exams is reflected in the following grades: 10 – remarkable; 9 – excellent; 8 – very good; 7 – good; 6 – satisfactory; 5 – failed. Students' success in exams at the University and its higher education units may not be shown numerically, but according to the following pattern: A+ – 10; A – 9; B – 8; C – 7; D – 6; F – 5. The final grade in an exam is calculated by total number of credits acquired in all forms of studying obligations.
