<p>Language Requirements</p>	<p>An adequate level of (spoken and written) German is required, as most of our courses are held in German. We do not require a German Certificate.</p>

<p>Housing (VERY IMPORTANT)</p>	<p>Finding accommodation is a very difficult issue here in Innsbruck. The students must apply as soon as possible to get a room in a student home (Studentenheim). Winter term: application recommended <u>in March</u> Summer term: application recommended <u>in September</u> Students must send the reservation deposit immediately, otherwise the application will not be handled.
